



Meals on Wheels Program

At the end of April, the Shire of Coolgardie launched its first ever Meals On Wheels service in response to the COVID-19 pandemic to assist seniors (70 years and over) in making the transition into self-isolation until they can put their own support mechanisms in place.

In Kambalda, the program has been made possible through funding support from Gold Fields St Ives and donations from Kambalda ESS Support Services. Rangecon Construction and Civil & Northern Star Resources have kindly donated meals for the Coolgardie community.

This project is a testament to the strong relationships the Shire has built with mining companies and service providers in our region. Their rapid response to community need, especially the most vulnerable members of the community, has been overwhelming.

- Coolgardie increase by 35% from Week 1 to 2
