Shire of Coolgardie From the desk of the CEO

Greetings to all,

I was fortunate to take a break with my family over the Christmas period, and took the opportunity to view a few particular museums on our travels in the South West region of our State, the area that our family originates from. I visited the Dardanup Machinery Museum, which has an incredible collection of running engines, pre 1950 cars, some steam engines, tractors and stationary benzene engines. This is a private collection owned by the Brooks family and is just amazing. I would thoroughly recommend it to anyone with an interest in old engines or old cars. I also visited the Bassendean Rail Museum, which is a display of static steam trains. The size of some of those trains was quite intimidating. I would imagine that they are a sight to behold when running. I also had plans to visit the Yarloop Steam Mill, which I last visited about 15 years ago (how time flies) but now it has very sadly been reduced to ashes. This is not only a great loss to the town but to the entire State. This loss really indicated to me how lucky we are in the Goldfields to have easy access to so much history, with old engines laying around and old mine sites sitting in the bush mostly in close to original condition. People in Perth would be envious if they had any inclination of what is laying about over the scarp.

With the weather cooling, our Summer Outdoor Movie series will be wrapping up toward April. Please come out and see a movie with your kids, or just as a chance to be outside with a friend. Being part of a small community, it is always nice to see anyone who turns up to enjoy a film and a snack.

The Shire of Coolgardie recently hosted a meeting in the Coolgardie Recreation Centre to gather comment on the proposal to move the Coolgardie Administration office into the Coolgardie Recreation Centre. I would like to thank everyone who attended and made comment. There are occasions that we seek public comment, and not many people (if any) turn up. It is always nice to have residents arrive to discuss their concerns, and we do our best to find a good outcome.

Shire representatives recently gate crashed a meeting in Kalgoorlie, to discuss where the location of the Kalgoorlie Boulder Drag Strip could be located. As the Shire of Coolgardie has been working on this for a few years, we were a bit confused about why this was being progressed when we already have progressed so far on locating a facility in Kambalda. It was a relief to hear that the Kalgoorlie/Boulder Mayor spoke on ABC radio, indicating his Shires support for a strip to be located in Kambalda. This is something that our Council has been working toward for some time, and forms part of the draft Town Planning Strategy number 5. Council have identified with local mines about 20ha of land for motor sport north of Kambalda, with at this time, only the Department of Minerals and Petroleum being the usual objector (imagine that).

At the Ordinary meeting of Council on 23 February 2016, our Council agreed to conditionally lease the old Railway Station and reserves to the Loopline. This is an absolutely outstanding result for the community with the Loopline demonstrating fantastic community based outcomes in Boulder. We will be working with Loopline and sectors of the Coolgardie community to get the best result for this community asset. I expect one of the first issues will be dealing with the high level of criminal damage inflicted on our old train and carriages, which is very disappointing. As a reminder, if you see damage happening on our train, or any other community asset, please report it to the police as soon as possible. Our police are interested in stopping crime, and getting the baddies. Please talk to them.

New group aims to empower Aboriginal people

The Coolgardie Aboriginal Advisory Group officially formed on Wednesday, 24 February 2016.

The group will act as an advisory on local Aboriginal issues to the Shire Council, and work with State Government Agencies to identify opportunity and improve the health and wellbeing of people living in the Shire of Coolgardie.

Shire of Coolgardie Chief Executive Officer, Paul Webb said "that it had been identified in Councils Strategic Directions Plan that consultation and engagement with the local Aboriginal community needed to be occurring in order to provide advice to Council on Aboriginal issues. The development of an Aboriginal Advisory Group not only assists with this directive but also provides our local Aboriginal community members with a much needed voice".

At a preliminary meeting the group identified a number of current concerns, including youth education and wellbeing, economic development and training opportunities, barriers to employment, drugs and alcohol abuse. The group discussed ways to address these issues and identified activities which would provide new opportunities for both Aboriginal people and the wider community.

Newly elected chairperson Rose Mitchell commented, "this is a great opportunity to assist the Shire and to help provide solutions and engage in something positive, and to unite the community".

Shire of Coolgardie Shire saves on Solar Panel Project



The Kambalda Community Recreation Facility has been fortunate enough to receive a 100 KW solar photovoltaic (PV) system installation, through grant funding that was awarded to the Goldfields Voluntary Regional Organisation of Councils (GVROC) from the WA Country Local Government Fund to carry out this installation. This project will align with the Goldfields-Esperance Region 2011-2021 Strategic Plan. The Shires of Esperance, Dundas, Ravensthorpe, Leonora, Laverton and Menzies are also scheduled to have a number of significant solar PV systems installed in the 2015/16 and 2016/17 financial years.

A technical analysis was completed in 2014 outlining Shire owned facilities that were ideal for solar PV installations. From this analysis it was suggested that the Kambalda Community Recreation Facility was suitable for installation of a 100kW solar PV system.

This project will save the Shire of Coolgardie a considerable amount in electricity costs each year and will reduce consumption of electricity from the grid and consequently, significantly reduce CO2 emissions currently generated. The construction tender has been awarded and the PV system is due to commence construction in mid April with a completion date of 28 May 2016. The Shire of Coolgardie is excited about the installation of the system and looking forward to seeing the reduction in the electricity charges to this particular building.

Bush Fires Act notice for owners and occupiers

This is a friendly reminder to all property owners and occupiers of your responsibility in regards to Fire Hazard Reduction as per The Bush Fire Act 1954.

Pursuant to the powers contained in Section 33 of the Bush Fires Act 1954, you are hereby required on or before the first day of November 2015 or within fourteen days of your becoming owner or occupier of land should this be after this day to clear all firebreaks and remove flammable materials from the land owned or occupied by you as specified hereunder and to have the specified land and firebreaks clear of all flammable materials from the first day of November 2015 up to the thirty first day of March 2016.

"Flammable material" does not include green growing trees or green growing plants in gardens. It also does not include plants native to the region that are fire resistant, for example; saltbush shrubs.

Kyle Matulin shaved 00.67 seconds off his already impressive 50m breaststroke time to a 47.75 and a 00.78 second PB in his 50m backstroke

Rianna Matulin brought home a Bronze medal, coming an overall 3rd place for her 50m backstroke with a time of 36.12 seconds.

Suddenly a passing motorist stops and races over to the car and rescues the man. In the process of the rescue the hero becomes severely burned. The man trapped in the car escaped any injury and was so relieved he was still alive that he just wanted to go and hug his wife and kids. He completely forgot about the man who rescued him. 
