#### Coolgardie Dawn Service

Approximately 180 people of all ages gathered for the 6.00am dawn service at the Returned Service League Memorial Garden.

The dark Coolgardie morning was awoken to the sound of the haunting music of the Last Post played by Charlie Cassis from Kalgoorlie. The commemorative speech honoring our soldiers and "In Flanders Fields" poem by Major John McRae was spoken by Willy Corcoran, who also played the bag pipes.

Jeremias Wade, Caleb Javapro and Jordan Essau were our Air Cadets who lowered the flags as the crowd silently laid the wreaths at the memorial, Mr Corcoran commented that "it was especially moving to see the young children who participated".

Robin Wade addressed the crowd acknowledging and thanking the Papua New Guinea Soldiers for their roles during the second world war and presented the Papua New Guinea Flag to Robert Javapro from the RSL Coolgardie Sub Branch.

The Sunrise completed the service with a stunning display of mauves, gold and orange sending threads of sunlight across the colours and textures of the wreaths and poppies that filled the Memorial and its gardens.

## Shire of Coolgardie From the desk of the CEO

Greetings to all,

The Shire of Coolgardie has recently been working on the review of the community Strategic plan. I thank those of the community that attended the meeting for input into this document that assists both the Council and the administration on how the community wishes to move forward over the next few years. I also thank our residents for the supportive way in which they approached this program. It has been a pleasure to work with my Council since 2011, and working toward the goals of that original plan.

We have managed to chew through a significant backlog of projects to get us where we are. Every year we work away at a few more projects, and every year our towns look a little better. Next financial year we will see completion of the Kambalda gabion walls. Not really in the public eye, this very important project has, and will assist in reduction of water flows through Kambalda town site up to a 1:100 year event.

Council have invested in this project for a number of years, and we look forward to hitting our completion target.

The Federal Government has also increased funding into the Roads to Recovery (R2R) program, which Council have put into the reseal program. For unknown reasons, our road reseal program had fallen off the radar many years ago, leaving the community with an extremely deteriorated asset. The additional injection of funds into this program will certainly assist in rationalising our asset gap in this area.

Administration is currently working on seeking funding for a number of strategic projects, being the Coolgardie Main street project, Kambalda Street Development Plan, and the Coolgardie Post Office complex.

Staff were seeking community input for these projects on the weekend of the 23 April, at the front of Moran's Store in Coolgardie (thankyou Patsy) and at Woolies in Kambalda (thankyou Mr Hooper).

Working on the Census is a great way to contribute to your community. The data you help collect provides an important statistical snapshot of Australia. It supports planning, policy and funding decisions for a range of local services and infrastructure—from housing and transport to health and education.

A few things have changed since the last Census. In 2016, most households will receive a letter giving them a unique login number and instructions on how to complete the Census online. Approximately 65 per cent of households are expected to complete the Census online however paper forms will still be available for households who need them.

Field Officers play a critical role by visiting households, encouraging online participation and ensuring everyone makes the count. And as a Field Officer, you'll earn around \$21 per hour, receive motor vehicle allowances and enjoy flexible working hours. You will also be responsible for daily administrative tasks and the security of Census materials.

You'll need to be a good communicator, reasonably fit, licensed to drive and willing to travel and work independently. Field Officers will also need to have access to home computer and internet.

The positions are part-time and most of the work will be conducted during August and September. People from diverse backgrounds are encouraged to apply.

## Shine a Light on Road Safety

Road Trauma Support WA is joining with the Road Safety Commission to **Shine a Light on Road Safety** in 2016 to highlight the devastating impact of road trauma on thousands of Australians each year.

The campaign will be run during Yellow Ribbon National Road Safety Week which runs from 2-8 May 2016 across the country.

The Shine a Light on Road Safety campaign originated in Victoria in 2013 and spread throughout the rest of Australia for the first time last year.

It's a timely reminder given the recent horrific road crash statistics that WA has recorded already for 2016.

The Road Safety Commission's <u>report</u> for the first quarter of 2016 revealed that 52 people died on our road's between January 1 and March 31st – with young males, those in country areas and motorcycle riders over represented in the crash data.

Road Trauma Support is asking all motorists to **Shine a Light on Road Safety** by switching on their headlights on Friday May 6<sup>th</sup> to raise awareness about road safety and to share the hashtag #shinealightonroadsafety.

Road Trauma Support WA is also working alongside the SARAH group (Safer Australian Roads and Highways) to raise awareness of Yellow Ribbon Road Safety Week by illuminating notable Australian landmarks across the country.

Perth will join other State capitals by illuminating iconic city buildings during the week, with Perth's Council House and The Bell Tower to be lit up and for the first time Elizabeth Quay will be illuminated in yellow on May 2 and 3 to help Shine a Light on Road Safety in 2016.

Road Trauma Support WA's Patron and the director of the WA State Trauma Unit at Royal Perth Hospital, Dr Sudhakar Rao has thrown his support behind the campaign as it works to try to effect positive behavioural changes on our roads.

"I personally treat the physical devastation that road trauma wreaks on far too many people in our community. "If we can all Shine a Light on Road Safety I know that together we can all make a difference," Dr Rao said. Shine a Light on Road Safety is a national campaign to raise awareness about road safety, to try and stop deaths and injuries on our roads and to highlight the effects on the thousands in our community affected by road trauma each year.

"Sadly issues surrounding road safety and its impact are more timely than ever given the Road Safety Commission's first report for 2016 which shows that already 52 people have died unnecessarily on our roads," according to Injury Control Council of WA Chief Executive Venessa Wells.

#### Voucher Incentive for Kambalda Women

Did you know that 4 out of 5 women who develop cervical cancer have either never had a pap smear or do not have them regularly?

As part of the 2016 Goldfields WA Cervical Cancer Prevention Program, Kambalda Family Practice is encouraging women to come in and make an appointment for a Pap smear.

Elizabeth Leroy, Community Nurse Manager said "Until June 24<sup>th</sup>, we have a limited number of \$30 Woolworth's vouchers to give to women who have not had a pap smear in the last two years, if she comes in and has her pap smear"

Dr Romany Gour, Kambalda GP, is one of the doctors throughout the Goldfields who are participating in a Cancer Council WA education program on the current and future guidelines for cervical screening.


In the Goldfields the cervical screening participation rate is only 42.9%, which is lower than the State rate of 55.5%.

"The biggest risk factor for cervical cancer is not having regular pap smears." said Dr Romany Gour "All women who have ever been sexually active between the ages of 18 and 69 years need to have regular pap smears as part of their ongoing health and wellbeing checks."

Pam Foulkes-Taylor, Cancer Council WA's Goldfields Regional Education Officer said "This incentive is funded by the WA Cervical Cancer Prevention Program and will only be on offer until June 24<sup>th</sup>. We hope that it will be one more good reason for women to come in and have a pap smear"."
