### **Shire of Coolgardie**

Message from the Shire President November 2016

I would like to announce to all staff and residents of the Shire, that I have resumed my duties as Shire President subsequent to three months recovering from illness. However I will continue to experience mobility issues for some time yet. I have received great support from my wife, Noeline, and my family, throughout this enduring ordeal, and it is good to be out and about again.

I would like to acknowledge my Deputy President, Cr Tracey Rathbone, and Acting CEO Jill O'Brien, for the tremendous job that they have done in keeping the operations of the Council and organisation, respectively functioning under extremely difficult circumstances in my absence. During this time, Council has appointed Mr James Trail to the position of Acting CEO for a twelve month period. Council and Staff will work together, consolidating the Shire's position, both financially, and looking at the long term aspects, which includes a Long Term Financial Plan, Corporate Plan and addressing Service Provision Levels to our communities that will be sustainable into the future.

The Shire's Town Planning Strategy, that has been with the WA Planning Commission for some seven months, has been returned requiring thirty modifications before it can be gazetted. One of the main stumbling blocks to the approval of this scheme is the continued objection, or the imposition of unacceptable conditions, on the development of the Industrial area in Coolgardie Townsite. Councillors, Staff and our Planning consultant, Plan West, are preparing a submission in response to the modifications from the WAPC, in the hope that we can resolve our differences to be able to gain approval for this strategy that has taken nearly seventeen years to prepare.

Myself and Manager Recreation and Regulatory services, Jill O'Brien, met with representatives from the Department of Minerals and Petroleum in Coolgardie on Friday 11 November. The purpose of the meeting was to gain a better understanding of why the DMP continued to impose the objections, or conditional orders upon any future development of the current Industrial area in Coolgardie.

The response was that because there was identified mineralisation along the strike zone the full length of the town boundary, by allowing any further infrastructure in the area would restrict further mining activity, and therefore stifle growth of the town. They also continue to push for the Shire to look at their preferred area to the southwest of the townsite to develop a new Industrial precinct. We informed them that our position was that there was a current demand for lots of industrial land and we could not wait years down the track and also if they would be prepared to add a further condition to the 21 year leases, that should these leases be developed with the necessary infrastructure the leasee could then apply for freehold title of that lot, so that it would be more acceptable to anyone seeking land in the affected area. We also discussed the motor complex site in Kambalda, which the DMP explained was on top of a nickel mine, whereby they have suggested a site further to the south that is free from such encumbrances, have conveyed these discussions to the Acting CEO for inclusion into our submissions to the WAPC.

Our Finance Staff are currently working with representatives from Moore- Stephens to reconcile all the financial and asset registers in order to prepare the Shire's Annual Audit report. It is hoped the draft report will be presented at the Audit Committee meeting this month so that we can finalise the report and hold our Annual Electors meeting in December.

Our Acting CEO has appointed Keith Dickerson, from RSA Works Management, on a short term contract to assist our Technical Services Team in setting out and scoping our road works programme

for the rest of this financial year. Projects that have been identified include: the local road resealing work, Coolgardie North and Ladyloch Road upgrades, the MRDWA Black spot intersections in Coolgardie and the Kambalda tip road and intersection. It is important to commence these projects as soon as possible in order to acquit funding from MRDWA.

An interesting statistic was given to me recently by our tech officer in Coolgardie, when they installed a traffic counter at the eastern end on Bayley Street. Over a two week period 34,500 vehicles passed through Coolgardie, with over 30% exceeding 60kph. That is a phenomenal amount of traffic passing through the town!!!

The partnership between the Shire and the Goldfields Employment Training group is gaining momentum, with members of the group participating in several ongoing projects in both Coolgardie and Kambalda. They have completed the restoration on the Lions Train at Steinhauser Park, and from all accounts have done an amazing job. They are also working on a gazebo for the rest area planned for the Coolgardie entry statement and have almost completed the signage to be installed around the Bluff cultural and heritage trail. With ongoing support this partnership will bring a lot of benefit to our communities for many years.

With the month of December upon us I would like to mention some of the events that are being planned for the residents of the Shire: Saturday 10 December the 50th Anniversary of the Kambalda Community Christmas Tree event and the Founding of the town of Kambalda. With increased funding, this year will see one of the biggest events on the Kambalda calendar for many years and will be an event not to be missed.

- \* Skateboarding WA will be conducting an event at the Kambalda West skate park on 13th December for the benefit of all ages of people who wish to participate. It is encouraging that these groups will come out to the regions and conduct these events for our youth.
- \* The Annual Seniors Christmas Luncheon will be Wednesday 14 December at the Coolgardie Recreation Centre. This is a much anticipated event whereby our senior citizens have a chance to socialize and celebrate the oncoming festive season.
- \* The Councillor and Staff Christmas party was held at the Kambalda West pool on Friday 2 December.

One other event I would like to mention is the Aboriginal Art Exhibition which was held in the old Pharmacy Building in Coolgardie. The Exhibition opened on Saturday 19 November and was open daily until Friday 25 November. There were 52 entries for the Exhibition and featured representatives across all sections of the community with local school children submitting entries. This event had been presented as part of the reconciliation programme agreement between the Shire and the Aboriginal Legal Service.

- Let your neighbours know you will be away and ask them to watch out for visitors and collect all your mail.
- Cancel all deliveries such as newspapers.
- Consider installing automatic timing devices for lights and electrical appliances such as radios and televisions.
- Give your house keys to a trusted friend, or neighbour, rather than hiding them outside your home.
- Be sure to notify the key holder when you return. This is especially important if you are returning home early.
- Give your neighbour or friend your contact address and telephone number.
- If you live in a neighbourhood watch area tell the co-ordinator that you'll be away and for how long.
- Consider asking your neighbour to park a car in your driveway.
- Your answering machine should simply say that you're unable to come to the phone.
- Consider leaving a pair of old work boots by the front door to give the impression that someone

### Grant makes a splash at local pool

4 November 2016

Pools across the region will be sparkling over summer thanks to the Liberal National Government's community pool funding program.

As part of the Community Pool Revitalisation Program, 95 pools and water playgrounds (where there is no pool) will share in \$2,923,728 of funding.

The Community Pools program allows eligible regional local governments to apply for up to \$32,000 towards pool upgrades, maintenance, equipment, staff development or a reduction of pool entry costs.

Member for Eyre, Dr Graham Jacobs MLA, congratulated the Shires in the electorate for applying and receiving the grant for the local community pools.

"The Esperance Bay of Isles Leisure Centre, Coolgardie Swimming Pool, Goldfields Oasis, Norseman Swimming Pool, Ravensthorpe Community Swimming Pool, Southern Cross Swimming Pool Complex and Westonia Memorial Swimming Pool have all received funding for upgrades, line marker ropes, signage and installation of music and public address system," Graham said.

"Local pools are an important public facility in regional towns."

"They play a really valuable role in our social life and help us feel connected to community but we also reap the wonderful mental and physical benefits of being active in the water," said Graham.

Funding for the annual Community Pool Revitalisation Program has been made possible with \$13.2 million over four years through the State Government's Royalties for Regions program.

This funding can also be placed in a specified reserve account and budgeted towards a larger capital project.

#### Patient survey confirms Telehealth a success in Mining and Pastoral Region

A recent patient survey into the use of Emergency Telehealth Service has generated outstanding feedback for the high-definition videoconferencing service.

Patients said Telehealth, which is used to link people in rural and remote areas to a range of clinicians in the State's major hospitals and health services, saves time and money and is far more convenient than city visits.

Member for the Mining and Pastoral Region Dave Grills MLC said more than 15,000 country patients had used the Telehealth service for outpatient appointments in the past year and the service was continuing to grow as people heard how convenient it was.

"It makes a big difference when regional and remote patients are able to see their specialist via videoconference from their local hospital and not have to make arrangements to leave family and work, travel for hours, and find accommodation," Mr Grills said.

"The overwhelming feedback was that patients who attended an appointment via Telehealth were very happy with the ease and quality of the service.

"It is clear Telehealth staff at the regional health services are seen by regional patients as professional and supportive and that using the Telehealth service is far better than having to travel to the city or a regional centre."

Almost all patients said the service was as effective as a face-to-face appointment and that speaking with their specialist from a regional site saved them time and money.

Nationals WA candidate for Kalgoorlie Tony Crook said the expansion of Telehealth was just one example of the State Government's significant investment in regional health care through *Royalties for Regions*.

"The response that 99 per cent of those surveyed would recommend the Telehealth service is a pretty clear indication of the success of this investment," Mr Crook said.

In 2015-16, there were almost 33,500 occasions of clinical service delivered by Telehealth. This comprises more than 16,500 emergency treatments, more than 5000 mental health appointments and almost 12,000 outpatient treatments.

Royalties for Regions has invested \$31 million into Telehealth, as part of the \$500 million Southern Inland Health Initiative.



Residents living in or near bushland are reminded to not rely on public water supplies if they plan to stay and defend their homes during a bushfire.

If you plan to stay and defend your home you must have an INDEPENDENT water supply and pumping capability. Scheme water may not be available due to damaged infrastructure, extreme demand depleting supply and pressure, or a cut to power which is used to pump water.

We have made our own preparations for the 2016-17 bushfire season by readying equipment and systems to cope with extreme conditions. Despite these efforts, it is likely there will be a reduction in water pressure, and scheme water supply tanks may run empty in the event of fire.



Burra Rock was oringinally used from 1921 utill 1937 to supply water for the steam trains on the narrow-gauge woodline railways. The steam trains were used to haul timber into Kalgoorlie-Boulder for the mines and fuel for industry.

Today this historical dam and catchment wall is a well known camping ground and a much loved spot for day trips. After a short walk up the rock you will be rewarded with a stunning view of the re-grown woodlands and a pretty swimming spot for the family.

Spend the weekend exploring the bush, hiking, swimming, photographing the wildlife and natural bush scenes. Spend your evenings enjoying the peace & quite, cooking up dinner on the BBQs in the campground and telling stories around the camp fire. Please remember to bring your own firewood with you (weather permitting) for the camp fire.

You will also find toilets and an information shelter at Burra Rock.

Burra Rock is located 60kms south of Coolgardie along the Burra Rock Road. It should take you about 45 mintues to an hour to get there from Coolgardie. It is accessable in a 2-wheel drive car.






