

Shire of Coolgardie Photography Competition

Terms and Conditions

1. Entry to this competition is deemed as acceptance of these terms and conditions.
2. This competition is being run and promoted by the Shire of Coolgardie.
3. Competition commences 9th of September 2020 and concludes 4pm 7th October 2020.
4. Entry into this competition is free.
5. The competition is open to amateur photographers (individuals for whom photography is not the source of their primary income).
6. All photographs submitted must have been taken within the Shire of Coolgardie boundaries.
7. A limit of three photographs can be submitted by each entrant.
8. All people photographed have provided consent for their images to be used.
9. By entering this competition, the entrant confirms the following:
 - a. The photograph is the entrant's original work.
 - b. The entrant is the sole owner and copywrite owner of the photograph.
 - c. The photograph has not been published, exhibited or have won a public competition previously.
 - d. The photograph was taken within the Shire of Coolgardie.
 - e. The entrant has consent from any people featured within the photograph.
 - f. The entrant ensures the content of the photograph is not offensive, illegal, of a pornographic nature or containing distressing content.
 - g. If the entrant is under 18years of age they have parental consent to enter.
 - h. The entrant agrees to having their name and photograph published.
 - i. The entrant gives Shire of Coolgardie permission to use submitted photographic images for promotional and marketing purposes, royalty free, at any time in future.
10. All entries must be high quality digital photographs, submitted in JPG format.
11. No date or time, titles or marks which may identify the author are permitted on the image itself.
12. Images presented for judging must be 100% photographic in origin. Composite images are not accepted. Images may not be digitally enhanced other than cropped or resized to suit required format.
13. Where possible, entrants will be credited with the photographs when they are used, however this is not guaranteed.
14. The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
