Message from the Shire President July 2016

The Coolgardie Post Office Complex restoration project is progressing well, with the roof replacement installed on the Sergeants Quarters, new guttering, downpipes and drainage in place. The Shire has received some good news, with the approval of funding from the GEDC to developed a business case for phase three of the funding application from the Goldfields Revitalisation R4R funding round, which will hopefully put us in a good position to be allocated further funding for the completion of this project.

The Shire has extended an invitation to David Tomasi and When Chai from our Auditors, Moore-Stephens to attend the Audit Committee meeting in August to address Council with regards to current Auditing practice, and also what will be required from the Shire in regard to improving procedures to reduce our Financial Ratios to the levels expected from the Department of Local Government in the future.

Sue and staff along with James Trail, are working extremely hard to produce a working Budget document for the 2016-17 financial year to be presented to the Audit and Finance Committee in early August, which if approved will then go before a Special Meeting of Council for adoption.

The Goldfields Employment Training group are currently working in partnership with VTEC, Carey Training and Focus Minerals in Coolgardie to run a 12 week Certificate III, training course in Civil Construction and Plant Operations at Focus Three Mile Hill plant. The 16 participants are gaining real life mining exposure, which will put them in good stead for future opportunities for employment in the mining or construction industry in the future.

Shire of Coolgardie From the desk of the CEO

Greetings to all

The Shire of Coolgardie has over the last five years, being working on a drainage mitigation project in the Kambalda West Town site. The project has required hand construction of a number of gabion rock structures that will in effect slow down natural water flows passing through the area. The design does not stop water passing through, but slows the volume of water over time to spread the volume of flow over a longer period.

The design phase was undertaken in the 2011/2012 period, with physical construction calculated to take 5 years, into the 2016/2017 financial period. Building the walls is a labour intensive process, requiring hand placement of stone into the wire cages. Mechanical dumping of rock into the cages causes bulge in the cage which will result in failure in the wall.

Thanks to a really innovative idea by the team, a removable aluminium box was designed to place the wire mesh cage inside of, and then the box could be mechanically filled with stone. The aluminium box is then removed by lifting with the loader off the cage. This significantly decreased the construction time on each cage, and as a result, this fantastic idea resulted in this back breaking project being completed 12 months ahead of schedule.

Having seen these types of construction before, I have never seen the box used for the laying of the cage. I believe we now have the opportunity to name the product, the 'Coolgardie Box', which we can proudly hold in esteem next to the 'Coolgardie Cooler'.

Structural repair work is also continuing on the Coolgardie Post Office complex, with the stone masons progressing stone replacement at the rear of the building. Having looked at the preliminary work on the side of the Sergeants Quarters, I must admit to being a little concerned, but after seeing the outstanding result at the rear of the building, I am quite confident that the completed works will fit the building very well. This is a heritage listed building, and as such, the works being conducted are compliant and be in keeping with the structure of the building. I would like to extend my thanks to Mrs Jill O'Brien, the Shire of Coolgardie Manager of Recreation and Regulatory Services for managing the contract process, which has seen this project move forward.

The Shire has also been very fortunate in being invited to the second round of submissions for the Post Office Complex. We have been funded through the GEDC for business plan on proposed works, which will need to be completed prior to consideration of funding. I very much hope for success in this project, as the building is of great importance to not only our town and Shire, but also to our region. The Shire administrations also applied for funding to the Coolgardie main street project, and Kambalda streetscape development plan, but in this instance were unsuccessful in making progress in this round. We will try again!

Feral Pigeon Cull

The shire of Coolgardie will be conducting a controlled pigeon cull in our public Heritage buildings (Coolgardie).

The presence of pigeons can result in a range of problems within these buildings.

These can include:

- Attracting ticks, cockroaches and rats.
- Damage to buildings and monuments due to the highly corrosive nature of acid in pigeon droppings.
- Damage to properties by pigeons roosting/breeding in roof spaces rolled steel joists and inside factory units.
- Debris from roosting flocks building up, causing gutters and drains to block damage to roofs and other structures and creating potential fire hazards.
- Extensive damage to air-conditioning units and other roof top machinery.
- Hygiene concerns due to pigeon droppings in/on industrial commercial and domestic buildings.
- Providing a vector for the introduction of weeds and disease.
- Escalating costs through public liability insurance from slipping on dropping build up.

If you breed pigeons and they are homing pigeons, please contact the Shire and we will advise you of the dates this programme will be running.

Regarding truth one theology Professor wrote, "Truth is that which is constant and unchangeable; something on which someone can rely, which will prove to be true in the future".
